"Self Regulation is taught through co-regulation...Luckily, perfection is not a requirement for regulation..."



We often hear from families who say they can't adopt because it's too expensive, but did you know that when using a county or adoption agency contracted through the State, there are no fees to adopt from foster care?

There may be minimal fees for the family should there be any purchase needs or home repairs to meet safety criteria. In addition, all household members over the age of 13 are required to complete a background study, at the expense of the family. Learn more.
