Foster parents needed!

In MN 2022 [[DHS Foster Care Fact Sheet](#)]:

- Approximately 7,700 children and young adults were in out of home care on any given day
- Approximately 12,400 children and young adults experienced out of home care throughout the year
- ~ 72% of children in care were 4 years old or older
- ~ 64% of children were living in Greater Minnesota

There are approximately 3,700 licensed foster homes in MN currently, and we'd love to see that number grow.
