Featured Child: Taj



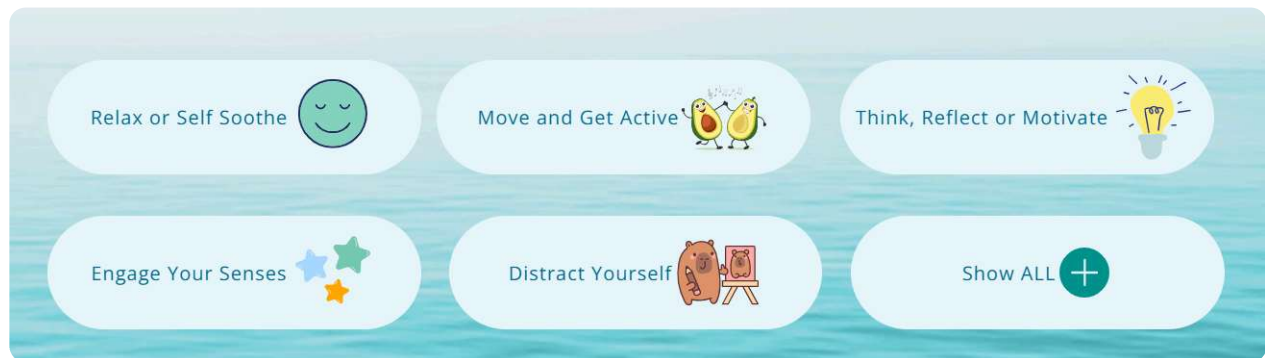

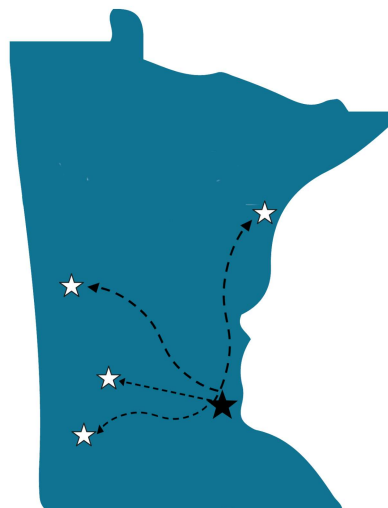

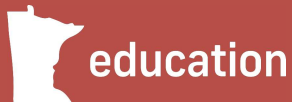
